

Call for Papers – TRIPS Flexibilities and Public Health

Deadline: 15 October

The South Centre and the Max Planck Institute for Innovation and Competition are organizing a **Global Forum on Intellectual Property, Access to Medicines and Innovation,** in Munich, on 9-10 December 2019.

The Forum is designed to bring together policymakers from developing countries with established scholars, early career academics and PhD students across multiple disciplines, allowing cross-fertilization of ideas that advance both scholarship and practice in the field.

This call for papers will receive **innovative ongoing and/or unpublished research from early career scholars and PhD students** on **substantive flexibilities in the IP system** afforded by the TRIPS Agreement **that are relevant to** pursue public health goals. Case studies, comparative analyses, empirical and statistical studies, as well as legal reflections with a policy perspective will be considered.

A finalized version of the proposed paper is a prerequisite for participation in the Forum. Upon further evaluation, the selected paper will be part of an upcoming book on TRIPS Flexibilities by the South Centre.
