Prime Minister Mahathir Mohamad of Malaysia announced that an independent commission, a "South Commission", would be set up to "try and work out solutions to major economic problems







### 1987

The South Commission became operational in August 1987 in Geneva. Composed of twenty-eight distinguished personalities from different walks of life and various parts of the developing world, the Commission examined the problems of developing countries

### 1990

The South Centre was established to follow-up the Report of the South Commission, entitled "The Challenge to the South", which provided recommendations on what the South could do to address continuing development challenges. It called for the South to work together collectively
