

SouthViews Publication Guidelines

The South Centre is the intergovernmental organization of developing countries that helps developing countries to combine their efforts and expertise to promote their common interests in the international arena.

The South Centre undertakes research and analysis oriented on various international policy areas that are relevant to the protection and promotion of the development interests of developing countries.

The South Centre works on a wide range of issues relevant to the countries of the South and the global community in general, such as sustainable development, climate change, South-South cooperation, financing for development, international tax cooperation, investment, human rights, gender, trade, intellectual property, innovation, traditional knowledge, access to medicines, health, antimicrobial resistance, biodiversity and the Fourth Industrial Revolution.

South Views is a service of the South Centre providing opinions and analysis of topical issues from a South perspective. It is posted on the South Centre website(s). Publication is announced on the Centre's social media. Announcements are also sent to the Group of 77 and China missions in Geneva, the South Centre e-mailing list and to other relevant networks.

Article and Submission Guidelines:

- Articles should preferably be up to **3000 words**.
- Please include your first and last name and a title for your article.
- Please include a short blurb (up to 3 sentences) for your article. If possible, please also include a blurb in French and/or Spanish. If this is not possible, the blurb will be translated into French and Spanish.
- Please indicate your current affiliation.
- External authors need to sign the Authorization to Publish form.
- To submit, e-mail your article to Anna Bernardo (Editorial Assistant) at <u>abernardo@southcentre.int</u> jointly with a scanned copy of the signed Authorization to Publish form.
- Include "SouthViews submission" in the subject line of your submission e-mail.
- Include a **contact e-mail address** in the body of your message. Your e-mail will appear in the article (unless you request it to be excluded).
- Articles should be sent as an attachment, in Word (.doc or .docx). Please do <u>not</u> send in .pdf format.
- Related pictures are highly encouraged to be submitted along with your article.

- Images must fall into one of these categories: [1] your own work—i.e. you took the photograph; [2] freely licensed; [3] public domain; [4] fair use. (E-mail abernardo@southcentre.int with any questions.)
- o Attach images to the same e-mail as your article submission.
- o Include a short (1 sentence) caption of each image.
- We will work with you via e-mail to edit and proof your submission prior to publication, as necessary.
